Successful social media is all about engagement! Simple questions are sometimes the best resources to get your audience to start to converse with you. But what to ask? That's where I come in.

THE GOALS

- To get people responding to you, on your page.
- To get people to talk amongst themselves on your post

SAMPLES OF QUESTIONS TO TRY

- Get Personal: "What book are you reading right now?"
- Pick questions that highlight a point you want to convey:
 "What movie character most highlights leadership to you?"
- Connect with Weather: "Favorite season?"
- Honor others: "What leader made an impact on your life?"
- Think Local: "Favorite business in our local community?"
- Give people a choice: "Mustard or Ketchup?"
- Get people to think: "What lesson from your grandparents still follows you today?"
- Cause people to connect with nostalgia: "What candy brings back a childhood memory?"
- Connect audience to a current trending topic: "Projected winner of today's game?"
- **Connect with people's emotions:** "What leadership quality is lacking in today's government?"
- Have fun: "What would you do if you were President?"
- Get them looking forward: "What lesson do you hope your children carry into the future with you?"

FINAL REMINDERS:

- Conversations will benefit your social media algorithms.
- Keep questions simple and clear to understand.
- Respond back to them, acknowledging their engagement.
- Ask questions that are unique, that touch a passion point, and that are easy for people to respond to without much thought.
- Make sure questions make sense, within your brand.

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
